

Each school will provide a 5 week block of cross country, either in lessons or as an extra-curricular club and time each individual child for a minimum of 3 runs over the 5 weeks.

Schools then submit their results to the local SGO who will provide district results.

There are several competitions to enter...


## District Competition:

The best 4 boys and 4 girls from each year group will be entered into the virtual district competition. Times will be ranked against all other district schools.

The top 2 teams from the virtual district competition will qualify for the face-to-face County Final at Keele University on $25^{\text {th }}$ June 2021.

## Challenge Format:

This is based on individual improvement over the 5 week block and the pupil who makes the most progress wins.
The winning individual in the Challenge Format will progress to the Virtual County Final.

## Teams

Each team is made up of 4 children in the same year group.
There are separate teams for boys and girls.

## Distances

We are relying on school staff to ensure the distances you ask the children to run are as accurate as possible:
Year 3 will compete over 400 m
Year 4 will compete over 600 m
Year 5 will compete over 800 m
Year 6 will compete over 1000 m

## ${ }^{1}$ Important!

I The races must take place in a 5 week consecutive block. As many schools I have planned their curriculum before the knowledge of this competition, the 5 , week period can take place in either the Autumn or the Spring terms. The I closing date for results to be submitted to SGOs is Friday $26^{\text {th }}$ March 2021


## Recording Results

We have produced an Excel spreadsheet for you to record your results in, there is a separate tab for each year group.

When entering times please convert all times to seconds only, e.g. 3 minutes 40 seconds $=220$.
Don't use decimal points!
Most cells on the spreadsheet are locked because they have formulas to calculate the results. You only need to enter names and times.
