

School Games National Summit 2024

Terms and Conditions

Orders and acceptance

- 1.1 The delegate is deemed to accept these terms and conditions (the "Terms") upon registering for the School Games National Summit 2024 (the "Event") and is responsible for ensuring the accuracy of all details submitted.
- 1.2 These Terms govern the booking for the Event and attendance at the Event. The Event website incorporates these Terms and they constitute a legally binding contract at the point of booking.
- 1.3 The closing date for bookings is 17:00 on Friday 31st May 2024 or earlier should capacity be reached.
- 1.4 Confirmation of the booking will be sent via an automated email at the time of registration.
- 1.5 The Youth Sport Trust will not reserve places. Places are offered on a first come, first served basis; the only delegates who have a guaranteed place at the Event are those who have received the email acknowledgement in 1.4.

Fees

- 2.1 The event is fully funded for SGOs, Active Partnerships and School Games NGBs and NDSOs. Tickets for additional places can be purchased at £120 + VAT per delegate ("delegate fee"), which includes all fees, materials and refreshments.
- 2.2 We will endeavour to accommodate all dietary requirements providing that the delegate provides this information within 14 days of the event, however we are unable to guarantee this.
- 2.3 All prices exclude VAT at 20% unless otherwise stated.
- 2.4 Accommodation is not included. All accommodation must be booked independently of the Youth Sport Trust.

Payments

3.1 Payment in full must be received and cleared by the Youth Sport Trust prior to the date of the Event as per the invoice payment terms. We accept payment by selected debit/credit cards, or bank transfer.

Cancellations

- 4.1 The Youth Sport Trust reserves the right to cancel or postpone the Event without notice. In the case of the Event being postponed, whether this is at the Youth Sport Trust's discretion or due to imposed national restrictions, delegate registrations will automatically be transferred to a revised date. For any delegates unable to attend this revised date, a refund will be issued. This request for a refund must be communicated in writing to <u>events@youthsporttrust.org</u>. Any refund will be limited to the amount already paid by the delegate to secure their place at the Event.
- 4.2 In the event of a cancellation by a delegate, cancellation fees will be due as follows (applies to paid for tickets only):



• 100% of the delegate fee will be charged for cancellations received after 17:00 on Tuesday 14th May 2024.

Substitutions will be permitted.

- 4.3 All cancellations or substitutions must be received in writing to: <u>events@youthsporttrust.org</u>
- 4.4 If a delegate is unable to attend the Event owing to a requirement or decision to self-isolate, due to Covid-19, a refund will be issued (delegates may be required to provide evidence, e.g., proof of a positive Covid-19 test). Any refund will be limited to the amount paid by the delegate to secure their place at the Event.
- 4.5 If applicable, refunds will be paid as soon as possible, or within 30 days.

Force majeure

- 5.1 The Youth Sport Trust will not be liable for any failure or delay in the delivery of the Event which is caused by circumstances beyond its reasonable control.
- 5.2 Where such circumstances occur, the Youth Sport Trust's obligations will be suspended for so long as such circumstances continue, or the Event may be cancelled, in which case the provisions of clause 4.1 will apply.

Venue, format and content of event

- 6.1 The Youth Sport Trust reserves the right to change the venue of the Event, when necessary, or to change the format of the Event to virtual delivery, if required. In the case of changes to the delivery format or venue, the Youth Sport Trust will inform delegates as soon as possible and provide information about the changes. If a change of venue or delivery format occurs, the Youth Sport Trust will not be liable for any additional costs incurred by delegates.
- 6.2 Speakers at any event hosted by the Youth Sport Trust speak on behalf of themselves or any organisation they represent. Opinions expressed by speakers are, therefore, not necessarily those of the Youth Sport Trust.
- 6.3 The Youth Sport Trust will endeavour to ensure that the published programme is provided. The Youth Sport Trust, however, reserves the right to alter the published programme according to circumstances.
- 6.4 Delegates must follow any health and safety requirements, including fire evacuation procedures, stipulated by the venue.
