

KS2 SEND New age kurling Festival

Main intent: Adapting the format to increase motivation.

School Games format and County NAK competition

Age group: KS2

Eligibility: this is open to any pupil with a statement for SEND. Selected competitors must be on the register of the school they represent.

Team size: each team will consist of 2 players.

Competition format: matches consist of 3 ends of 4 stones per team.

Scoring:

Points - 2pts for each end won

-1pt draw

- 0pt loss

Scores for where the stones finish

-White =10

-Blue =5

-White =4

-Red =3

-White corners =2

-Off the mat =1

AVSSP (Charlie's!) NAK festival format

Age group: KS2

Eligibility: this is open to any pupil with a statement for SEND but also pupils who have been highlighted at school for SEND but may not have a statement.

Team size: max of 4 per team.

Competition format:

Round robin where each team plays all the other teams at least once (ideally twice so first time is a warm-up).

Scoring – the closest team to the bullseye wins (only taking into account the closest stone for each team). 1pt for a win and 0pt for a loss.

Bullseye round (if time). Played as an individual. Each pupils get one stone and the closest to the bullseye gets a medal. Stones are collected after each stone so the alley is clear.

Please note I play a different format to School Games in order to involve more pupils and have more of a team emphasis to the event.

Please note that the winner of each festival will gain at place at the County final (date TBC) but will have to abide by the School Games format for the County competition.

Schools to bring own 1st Aid kit and to ensure each pupil has a snack and a drink.

This is one of the few opportunities for a purely SEND event so please, when choosing your pupils, consider all those on your SEND list, especially those that never normally get the chance to take part. I have a kurling stones ramp to make the event accessible for wheelchair users. Please pass this on to your SENCo to liaise with me if easier.

Schools can enter two teams but if you wish to enter more please add reserve team(s) and I will fill any spaces fairly once the deadline for entry has ended. Please complete and return the entry team sheet.

Deadline for entry: Wednesday 17th January

£15 per school entry

All schools MUST complete an entry team sheet.
