

















Yr4&5 orienteering Festival



Tuesday 23rd April @ Marl College (cricket/rugby pitches) Wednesday 24th April @ Zouch primary (school field)

Main intent: Using technology to develop physical skills

Team size: max of 10 participants per team, consisting of 5 pairs.

No restriction on ratio of boys and girls.

Pupils must be in either Yr4 or Yr5.

Schools will be given an allotted arrival time and they should allow for 90mins,.

They will be given a time limit of one hour to complete the course(s) and any extra time is for getting in and out of the venue, using toilets, having info/demo session.

Allotted times will be given out once the deadline has passed and as a result <u>I have made it an advanced</u> deadline date as I am aware schools need to book transport in.

I will allow schools to enter 2 teams and if you wish to put a team on the reserve list please let me know and if any spaces after the deadline has ended I will allocate them fairly.

Competition format

- Pairs must ensure they stay together as they make their way around the course.
- Each pair will head off at timed intervals around a course(s).
- The team with the quickest time will be the winner.

Pupils will be outside on grass so please ensure pupils are appropriately dressed for the activity and weather.
