Main intent: Adapting the competition environment to support individual development in sport.

The main rules for the festivals:

- 6 players with a max squad of 10. There should be 3 boys and 3 girls on the court at any time.
- Sets are 2mins and a match is 6 sets in total (this will depend based on number of entries).
- Winner of a set eliminates all opposition or has more players left at end of time.
- 3 foam dodgeballs placed along centre line at start. The ball on the team's left is their ball to collect and the middle one is the contested one. A ball is only live at the very start when it is passed back beyond return line.
- A ball is 'live' until it hits the floor or wall.
- A player struck by a live ball is out, face shots do not count. A player if out if they are struck by a ball which deflects off a teammate. When 'out' they must sit in outbox or on bench.
- A catch on a live ball means the thrower is out and the catching team gain a player from the outbox/bench. A catch is valid if it has deflected off a teammate whilst live.
- Players can use a ball in their possession to block an incoming ball. If the all they are holding is knocked from their possession they are out.
- No stalling allowed if holding all the balls.
